## The basis for updating EP 6B04220 "Jurisprudence"

For the 2021-2022 academic year according to the recommendations of social partners and the National Chamber of Entrepreneurs of the Republic of Kazakhstan "Atameken", the following disciplines were introduced into the OP "Jurisprudence": "Criminal and legal characteristics of offenses in the field of healthcare", "Legal regulation of securities", "Currency law of the Republic of Kazakhstan", "Medical law", "Insurance law of the Republic of Kazakhstan".

The following disciplines were redistributed by semesters: "Public international law" was moved from the 3rd to the 5th semester, "Public service and the basics of local self-government" was moved from the 5th to the 3rd semester, "Administrative process in the Republic of Kazakhstan" was moved from the 7th to the 4th semester, "Labor law and social security law of the Republic of Kazakhstan" was moved from the 4th for the 7th semester, "Criminology" was moved from the 7th to the 6th semester, "Advocacy and Notary" was moved from the 4th to the 6th semester. In accordance with the above changes, adjustments were made to the results of training No. 1, 2 and 6.
