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## 1. Explanatory note

The modular educational program (MOE) is compiled in accordance with the regulation On the formation of the trajectory of students' education p.01.04/2012, as well as on the basis of the provision of the State Educational Standard of the Republic of Kazakhstan from the Ministry of Education and Science of the Republic of Kazakhstan No. 604 dated 31.10.2018 "State mandatory standard of higher Education of the Republic of Kazakhstan. Higher education. Bachelor course. Basic provisions", Rules for the organization of the educational process on credit technology of training, the Standard curriculum of the educational program 6B10228 "Social work"

The MOS is designed as a set of sequential training modules for the entire period of study and is aimed at mastering the competencies necessary for awarding a bachelor's degree in the field of services under the educational program 6B10228 "Social Work"

The modules of the OOD block (a total of 51 credits) include disciplines common to all specialties of education, in the study of which the graduate must master the following competencies: knowledge of the laws of the development of society and its socio-political, legal, economic, environmental foundations, as well as cultural and historical values, the basics of computer science, language communication and understanding of the principles of a healthy lifestyle, possession of information about the political life of the country. KV – 5 credits.

The DB block includes disciplines of the university component (OK) - 42 credits; and elective components (KV) - 70 credits. The modules of these disciplines form a set of competencies: the formation of professional qualities, covering deep scientific, theoretical and methodological knowledge, practical skills and skills in historical, theoretical and branch sciences in the field of social services of the population.

The PD block includes disciplines of the university component (OK) -23 credits; and elective components (KV) - 37 credits. Modules of these disciplines allow you to form a complex of key and special competencies acquired by a graduate: the formation of professional qualities, including theoretical and empirical knowledge, as well as skills for practical actions, the ability to analyze and solve social problems of a theoretical and practical nature in the field of social services, Can perform the roles of: the performer of clearly defined tasks; the organizer of a separate line of activity; the coordinator of the efforts of various persons to organize specific activities; diagnostic activity - the study of the characteristics of the family, individual, group, the establishment of a "social diagnosis"; predictive activity - the study of trends in social tension in society, demographic situation, public opinion about the state of social protection.

## 2. THE GRADUATE'S COMPETENCE MODEL

A graduate of the educational program 6B10228 "Social Work" is awarded a bachelor's degree in the field of services.

The professional activity of a specialist social worker consists in helping people who need it, who are unable to solve their life problems without outside help, and in many cases to live (social and household assistance, socio-informational, socio-legal, socio-economic, socio-rehabilitation, medical and social, socio-psychological, socio-pedagogical, etc.), social protection (working, unemployed, large families, etc.) social services; social and medical services to the population; psychosocial work.

The objects of professional activity of a specialist are bodies, organizations of various organizational and legal forms in the system of social protection of the population, education, health, culture; penitentiary system, socio-pedagogical, socio-psychological services of specialized organizations (family orphanages, boarding schools, social shelters; youth organizations and associations; treatment and prevention and other medical organizations; rehabilitation centers for various categories of the population; social services in the socio-industrial sphere.

The main task of the specialty: a specialist social worker should have a high intellectual potential, deep knowledge of the general laws of the development of nature and society, be widely educated, have a scientific outlook. A social worker should have an idea about the processes and phenomena occurring in inanimate and living nature, about the basic socio-political, legal, socio-economic teachings in the field of humanities and socio-economic sciences; about the socio-cultural system; the peculiarities of the interaction of personality, culture and social system;

A graduate of the educational program 6B10228 "Social Work" is able to conduct organizational and managerial activities to provide social assistance to a client or a group of persons. It can perform the roles of: the performer of clearly defined tasks; the organizer of a separate line of activity; the coordinator of the efforts of various persons to organize specific activities; diagnostic activity - the study of the characteristics of the family, individual, group, the establishment of a "social diagnosis"; prognostic activity - study of trends in social tension in society, demographic situation, public opinion about the state of social protection, the need for it; information and communication activities - identification, collection, generalization of information about people in need of social assistance, and bringing it to the subjects; creation of a data bank about the family and individuals in need of social assistance; mediation activities in ensuring the client's communication with all necessary services; socio-medical activity in the organization of work on health prevention, promotion of a healthy lifestyle; socio-pedagogical activity in identifying the interests and needs of people in various activities and involving various institutions, societies, organizations, public, creative and other unions in working with them;

A graduate of the educational program 5B090500 "Social work" after mastering the MOS must have the following competencies:
