MODULAR EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM according to the educational program 6B01606- "History" Year of admission – 2021

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1. Explanatory note of the educational program 6B01606 - "History"

The modular educational program (MEP) is compiled on the basis of the State Mandatory Standard of Higher Education approved by the Order of the Ministry of Education and Science of the Republic of Kazakhstan No. 604 dated 31.10.2018. The Regulation on the introduction of educational programs (Order 01.26/2019). Regulations on the dual system of education at the Kazakh Humanitarian and Legal Innovation University (Order 01.13/2019). The structure of the modular educational program was approved by the Academic Council of the University (Protocol No. 5 of 17.01.2014). Rules of registration for Elective Component Disciplines (Order 01.18/2019).

Considering the levels of the National Qualifications Framework (NQF) and the Sectoral Qualifications Framework in Education (ORC). NRK and ORC in the field of education give grounds to recognize the results of both formal and informal and formal training, create conditions for access to assessment and recognition of qualifications not only by the academic environment, but also by employers.

During the updating of educational programs by stakeholders on 05.02.2021, an online seminar was held on the topic "Formation of competencies of a specialist competitive in the labor market". During the seminar, the issues of employment of young specialists, partnership, work experience were discussed with employers, as well as experts on OP 6B01606 "History" shared their opinions and suggestions. For example, a specialist of the Semipalatinsk Regional Museum of Local Lore, Tortenova Gulnur Shalataevna, a history teacher of the multidisciplinary college of Semey Smagulova Shynar Sovetkhanovna and history teacher Nygmanbekova G. M. according to the educational program 6B01606 "History", it was proposed to introduce several elective disciplines "Criterion assessment and technologies in history teaching", "Modern history course in secondary education" and "IT in history teaching" (Protocol No. 2 of 05.02.2021).

Modular educational programs are designed to provide a unified approach to the formation of educational programs on credit technology training. They are developed on the basis of regulatory documents of the Ministry of Education and Science of the Republic of Kazakhstan on the creation of methodological foundations for the development of educational programs. This regulation contains a description of the learning outcomes based on Dublin descriptors and competencies, the definition of general and subject competencies, requirements for the development of an educational program on a modular basis

The MEP is designed as a set of sequential training modules for the entire period of study and is aimed at mastering the competencies necessary for awarding a bachelor's degree in the educational program - 6B01606 – History.

The modules of the OOD block (OK 51 credits) and elective components (KV) - 5 credits, include disciplines common to all educational programs, during the study of which the graduate must master the following competencies: : knowledge of the laws of development of society and its socio-political, legal, economic, environmental foundations, as well as cultural and historical values, the basics of computer science, language communication and understanding of the principles of a healthy lifestyle, possession of information about the political life of the country.

The DB block includes disciplines of the university component (OK) - 41 credits and elective components (KV) - 71 credits. The modules of these disciplines form a set of competencies: the formation of professional qualities, covering deep scientific, theoretical and methodological knowledge, practical skills and skills in historical, theoretical and branch sciences in the field of the educational program.

The PD block includes disciplines of the university component (OK) - 20 credits; and elective components (KV) - 40 credits. Modules of these disciplines allow you to form a complex of key and special competencies acquired by a graduate: the formation of professional qualities, including theoretical and empirical knowledge, as well as skills for practical actions, the ability to analyze and solve geographical problems, for successful problem solving.

The criterion for the completion of the educational process is the student's mastering of 228 credits of theoretical training and the IGA - 12 credits of the MOS consists of 19 modules.

Duration of training - 4 years

1.2 The purpose of the modular educational program B015 "Teacher training in humanitarian subjects" **6B01606- "History" in accordance with the mission of** the university are: ensuring the training of professional teachers in the field of historical education who are able to carry out analytical, research and practical activities aimed at updating and improving the education system in modern conditions.

The main objectives of OP 6B01606 History are: the formation of fundamental knowledge and professional competencies necessary in practice, providing the secondary education system with teachers-historians capable of successfully competing in the domestic and foreign labor market, achieving integration into the European educational and research space
