1. Explanatory note of the educational program 6B01510 – "Geography-History"

The modular educational program (MOE) is based on:

- The State standard of higher and Postgraduate education, approved by the Order of the Minister of Science and Higher Education of the Republic of Kazakhstan dated July 20, 2022 No. 2;
- Rules for the organization of the educational process on credit technology of education, approved by the Order of the Minister of Education and Science of the Republic of Kazakhstan dated April 20, 2011 No. 152;
- Standard rules of activity of organizations of higher and (or) postgraduate education, approved by the Order of the Minister of Education and Science of the Republic of Kazakhstan dated October 30, 2018 No. 595;
- Professional standard "Teacher" approved by the Order of the Chairman of the Board of the National Chamber of Entrepreneurs of the Republic of Kazakhstan "Atameken" No. 133 dated June 8, 2017;
 - Structures of the modular educational program (Form No. 26, revision No. 3 of 08.10.2021).

The modules of the OOD block (OK 51 credits) and elective components (KV) - 5 credits, include disciplines common to all educational programs, during the study of which the graduate must master the following knowledge of the laws of the development of society and its socio-political, legal, economic, environmental foundations, as well as cultural and historical values, fundamentals of computer science, language communication and understanding of the principles of a healthy lifestyle, possession of information about the political life of the country.

The DB block includes disciplines of the university component (OK) - 41 credits and elective components (KV) - 71 credits. Modules of these disciplines form scientific, theoretical and methodological knowledge, practical skills and abilities in the field of geography and history.

The PD block includes disciplines of the university component (OK) - 25 credits and elective components (KV) - 35 credits. Modules of these disciplines allow you to form a complex of key and special knowledge acquired by the graduate about professional qualities, including theoretical and empirical knowledge, as well as skills for practical actions, the ability to analyze and solve geographical and historical problems, for successful problem solving.

The criterion for the completion of the educational process is the student's mastering of 228 credits of theoretical training and 12 credits of final certification. The MOS consists of 21 modules.
