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1. EXPLANATORY NOTE

The Modular Educational Program (MEP) was developed by:

- on the basis of the State Standard of Higher and Postgraduate Education, approved by the Order of the Minister of Science and Higher Education of the Republic of Kazakhstan dated July 20, 2022 No. 2;
- in accordance with the Rules for organizing the educational process on credit technology of education, approved by order of the Minister of Education and Science of the Republic of Kazakhstan dated April 20, 2011 No. 152;
- in accordance with the Model rules for the activities of organizations of higher and (or) postgraduate education, approved by order of the Minister of Education and Science of the Republic of Kazakhstan dated October 30, 2018 No. 595;
- in accordance with the Professional standard "Teacher", approved by the Deputy Chairman of the Board of the National Chamber of Entrepreneurs of the Republic of Kazakhstan "Atameken" dated June 8, 2017. No. 133;
- in accordance with the approved structure of the MEP (edition No. 4 of 05.10.2022);
- taking into account the recommendations of employers.

The modular educational program is developed as a set of sequential training modules for the entire period of study and is aimed at mastering the competencies necessary for the assignment of an academic bachelor's degree in the Educational program 6B01708 "English with additional learning of a second foreign language".

The modules of the block of general education disciplines (GED) (56 credits in total, of which CC (compulsory component) - 51 credits, CCh (components by choice) - 5 credits) include disciplines common to all educational programms, in the study of which the graduate must master the following competencies: knowledge of the laws of the development of society and its socio-political, legal foundations, as well as cultural and historical values, the basics of informatics, linguistic communication and understanding of the principles of a healthy lifestyle, knowledge of the political life of the country.

The block of basic disciplines (BD) (112 credits in total) includes disciplines of the university component (UC - 48 credits) and components by choice (CCh - 64 credits). The modules of these disciplines form a complex of competencies: the formation of basic and professional qualities, covering deep scientific, theoretical and methodological knowledge, practical skills in theoretical and industrial sciences in the field of education.

The block of profiling disciplines (PD) (60 credits in total) includes the disciplines of the university component (UK - 15 credits) and components by choice (CCh - 45 credits). The modules of these disciplines make it possible to form a complex of key and special competencies acquired by a graduate: the formation of professional qualities, including theoretical and empirical knowledge, as well as skills for practical actions, the ability to analyze and solve pedagogical problems of a theoretical and practical nature in the field of education and upbringing.

The criterion for the completion of the educational process is the development of at least 240 credits by the student, of which 228 credits are theoretical training and 12 are final certification.

The modular educational program consists of 24 modules.

Aim of EP - training of competitive specialists - teachers of foreign languages who have fundamental knowledge, skills and competencies necessary in professional activities, and who speak foreign languages at a level recognized by the international community and meeting the needs of the society of the Republic of Kazakhstan.

Expected results of the educational program:

ON1: To plan, design and conduct training lessons in foreign languages, integrating knowledge from various subject areas in solving pedagogical problems; to develop teaching materials on foreign language, using traditional, innovative, information and communication educational technologies and methods, as well as new achievements in the field of psychological and pedagogical sciences.

ON2: To form and develop the linguistic, communicative, informational, professional competencies of students, to organize foreign language communication in the lesson, using creative, interactive and other forms of work with students.

ON3: To collect and interpret information for the formation of judgments, taking into account social, ethical and scientific considerations; to model the educational process and build a favorable educational environment, using the results of diagnosing the individual and age characteristics of students, their development by means of a subject through the use of critical thinking technologies; identify needs and difficulties in teaching foreign languages.

ON4: To master basic and second foreign languages; skills of constructive dialogue, communication in a multi-ethnic and multi-confessional society.

ON5: To comply with business ethics and socio-ethical values, find compromises when working in a team and adequately navigate in various social situations; based on the forms and methods of cooperation in the professional community and interaction with various social groups, initiate innovative ideas uniting education stakeholders and involve them in the educational process.

To create special conditions for people with special educational needs to receive education, the competence model of a graduate is complemented by professional competencies that ensure the adaptive nature of the main educational program. To this end, the catalog of courses of the additional educational program "Minor" includes courses for the formation of people with special educational needs of the ability to successfully socialize in society and actively adapt to the labor market, taking into account the characteristics of the disease.
