1. Explanatory note of the educational program 6B01606 - "History"

The modular educational program (MEP) is compiled on the basis of the

- ✓ State Standard of Higher and Postgraduate Education, approved by Order No. 2 of the Minister of Science and Higher Education of the Republic of Kazakhstan dated July 20, 2022;
- ✓ Rules for organizing the educational process on credit technology of education, approved by Order No. 152 of the Minister of Education and Science of the Republic of Kazakhstan dated April 20, 2011;
- ✓ Standard Rules of Activity organizations of higher and (or) postgraduate education, approved by the Order of the Minister of Education and Science of the Republic of Kazakhstan dated October 30, 2018 No. 595;
- ✓ Professional standard "Teacher", approved by the order of the Chairman of the Board of the National Chamber of Entrepreneurs of the Republic of Kazakhstan "Atameken" No 500 dated December 15, 2022.

The MEP is designed as a set of sequential training modules for the entire period of study and is aimed at mastering the competencies necessary for awarding the Bachelor of Education degree in the educational program 6B01606 - "History"

Bolk general education disciplines (BGED) – consists of 56 credits, of which the disciplines of the obligatory component (OK) 51 credits and the disciplines established by the university (UV) 5 credits. The modules of these disciplines form a complex of general educational competencies: knowledge of the ideological nature; the culture of thinking, its general laws and its socio-political, legal, economic foundations, as well as cultural and historical values, the basics of computer science, language communication and possession of a system of subject, psychological, pedagogical and methodological knowledge.

The block of basic disciplines (BD) consists of 112 credits, of which the disciplines of the university component (VC) – 40 credits and elective components (CV) – 72 credits. Modules of these disciplines form a complex of general professional and special competencies: formation - to form an idea about pedagogical activity, about the role of a teacher in the pedagogical process and about the features of the management process, to understand and apply deep scientific, theoretical and methodological knowledge, practical skills and skills in historical, theoretical and branch sciences in the field of educational program.

The block of profile disciplines (PD) consists of 64 credits, of which the disciplines of the university component (VC) - 25 credits and elective components (CV) - 39 credits. Modules of these disciplines allow to form a complex of professional and special competencies acquired by a graduate: to apply in practice basic knowledge of national and world history, revealing the content of the processes of acquisition, systematization and use of knowledge; to choose and apply in practice methods, forms, modern educational technologies in teaching historical disciplines; to apply various types of methods of historical and psychological research in accordance with the goals and objectives of the practice

The total number of credits upon completion of the educational program 6B01606 "History" is 240 credits. The MEP consists of 19 modules. The training period is 4 years.

The purpose of the modular educational program 6B01606- "History" is: to provide training for professional teachers in the field of historical education who are able to carry out analytical, research and practical activities aimed at updating and improving the education in modern conditions.

In order to create special conditions for people with special educational needs to receive education, the graduate's competence model is supplemented with professional competencies that ensure the adaptive nature of the main educational program. For this purpose, courses for the formation of the ability of persons with special educational needs to successfully socialize in society and actively adapt to the labor market, taking into account the characteristics of the disease, are introduced into the catalog of courses of the additional educational program "Minor".
