#### I. EXPLANATORY NOTE

The modular educational program (MEP) was developed by:

- on the basis of the State Standard of Higher and Postgraduate Education, approved by Order of the Minister of Science and Higher Education of the Republic of Kazakhstan dated July 20, 2022 No. 2;
- in accordance with the Rules for organizing the educational process in credit technology of education, approved by order of the Minister of Education and Science of the Republic of Kazakhstan dated April 20, 2011 No. 152;
- in accordance with the Standard Rules for the activities of organizations of higher and (or) postgraduate education,
   approved by order of the Minister of Education and Science of the Republic of Kazakhstan dated October 30, 2018
   No. 595;
- in accordance with the Professional Standard "Teacher", approved by the order of the acting Minister of Education of the Republic of Kazakhstan dated December 15, 2022 No. 500.
- in accordance with the approved structure of the MOP;
- taking into account the recommendations of employers.

The modular educational program is developed as a set of sequential educational modules for the entire period of study and is aimed at mastering the competencies necessary to award the degree "Bachelor of Education in the educational program 6B01707 - "Kazakh language and literature".

In the modules of the block of general education disciplines (GED) (56 credits in total, of which GC (mandatory component) - 51 credits, university component (VC - 5 credits) included disciplines common to all educational programs, during the study of which the graduate must master knowledge of the laws of development of society and its socio-political, legal foundations, as well as cultural and historical values, the fundamentals of computer science, language communication and understanding of the principles of a healthy lifestyle, information about political, economic life of the country.

The block of basic disciplines (BD) (112 credits in total) includes disciplines of the university component (VC - 39 credits) and elective components (CR - 73 credits). The modules of these disciplines form basic and professional qualities, covering deep scientific, theoretical and methodological knowledge, practical skills in theoretical and industrial sciences in the field of education .

The block of major PD disciplines (64 credits in total) includes disciplines of the university component (VC - 30 credits) and elective components (CL - 34 credits). The modules of these disciplines cover the basic and special competencies that a graduate must have: the formation of professional quality, including theoretical and empirical knowledge, as well as a sequence

of disciplines, including the theoretical and practical significance of issues of the Kazakh language and literature, methods of teaching the Kazakh language and literature.

The criterion for completing the educational process is that the student has completed at least 240 credits.

### The purpose of the educational program 6B01707 – "Kazakh language and literature":

Training of competitive specialists who have received a high-quality professional comprehensive education in the field of Kazakh language and literature, who are able to work effectively for the benefit of society and the state, who have intercultural and communicative competencies and use information technology in teaching activities.

## Expected results of the educational program 6B01707 - "Kazakh language and literature":

**ON1:** Plan and conduct training sessions on the subjects of Kazakh literature, using traditional and innovative technologies; know new achievements in the field of psychological, pedagogical and philological sciences, the basics of teaching methods, and apply modern educational information technologies.

**ON2:** Understand the basic theoretical principles of the Kazakh language and use this knowledge to achieve results, be able to carry out linguistic analysis.

**ON3:** Apply appropriate teaching methods and means of assessing educational achievements, taking into account the acquired scientific and theoretical knowledge in the Kazakh language, the characteristics and needs of students, plan professional development independently.

**ON4:** Comply with the norms of pedagogical ethics and socio-ethical values, find compromises when working in a team and adequately navigate various social situations; based on forms and methods of cooperation in the professional community and interaction with various social groups, organize subject-subject interaction of all participants in the pedagogical process, master the technology of managing the educational process; cooperate with parents, teachers and society; organize educational work

with children and adolescents, taking into account the anatomical and physiological characteristics of the body at different age periods, as well as taking into account hygienic requirements in the educational process and extracurricular activities.

**ON12:** Know the periodization of the history of Kazakh literature, basic terminology, be able to carry out a comprehensive literary and theoretical analysis of a literary text.

To create special conditions for receiving education for persons with special educational needs, the competency model of the graduate is supplemented with professional competencies that ensure the adaptive nature of the main educational program. For this purpose, the catalog of courses of the additional educational program "Minor" includes courses to develop in persons with special educational needs the ability for successful socialization in society and active adaptation in the labor market, taking into account the characteristics of the disease.
